

Eligibility

- Participants must be currently enrolled as undergraduate students at accredited educational institutions worldwide.
- Participation can be individual or in teams.
 - In the case of team entries, each member must meet the eligibility requirements, and interdisciplinary teams are strongly encouraged.
- Participants must submit a detailed proposal outlining their ESG-focused idea or solution.
 - The proposal should clearly articulate the environmental, social, and governance aspects of the project.
- Submissions must demonstrate creativity, innovation, and originality in addressing sustainability challenges.
