ESG Innovation Challenge: Shaping a Sustainable Future is an undergraduate student ESG idea competition designed to empower the next generation of leaders in Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) practices.



The purpose of this competition is to foster creativity, critical thinking, and collaboration among undergraduate students, inspiring them to develop innovative solutions that address the practical application of ESG principles.



ELIGIBILITY

Participants must be currently enrolled as undergraduate students at accredited educational institutions worldwide.



Participation can be individual or in teams.

In the case of team entries, each member must meet the eligibility requirements, and interdisciplinary teams are strongly encouraged.



Participants must submit a detailed proposal outlining their ESG-focused idea or solution.

The proposal should clearly articulate the environmental, social, and governance aspects of the project.



Submissions must demonstrate creativity, innovation, and originality in addressing sustainability challenges.

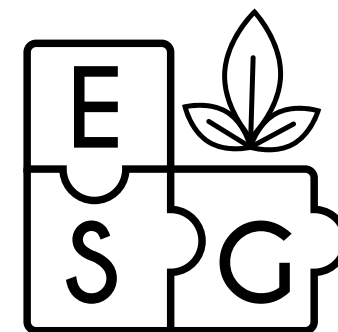
